hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

Water is proposed to be used for recreational purposes including overnight camping facilities, day use areas, group facilities and related uses. Access to the spring area by wildlife will not be blocked, and water will be left in the source for their needs as a part of the recreational use. Annual needs are estimated to be 200 AF/year from all sources.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.25 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permits 38418, 38419, and 40182 shall not exceed 65.165 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 58.98 million gallons annually.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 28, 1981
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 28, 1981
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 28, 1982
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 28, 1982
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 28, 1983
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 28, 1983
